SB 423 Extends Streamlining for Affordable Housing



RCD was proud to support SB 423, which extends an existing permit streamlining pathway for 100% affordable housing development in cities that are behind on their housing goals. This successful streamlining process has cut the time it takes to entitle our affordable developments in half. Its extension through 2035 is a huge win for quick and cost-effective affordable housing development!
