Supporting ACA 1

RCD was proud to be part of a coalition supporting ACA 1 to place Proposition 5 on the November 2024 ballot. Prop 5 would lower the vote threshold for housing and infrastructure bonds, making it easier for communities to fund local projects. While Prop 5 eventually did not pass, the campaign demonstrated powerful support for grassroots solutions to local challenges.
